



Registration Code of Conduct

Personal Accountability Commitment

By attending AWCI's Convention & INTEX Expo you agree to abide by and engage in certain beneficial health and safety conduct while attending the event. This includes, but is not limited to, submitting to daily temperature checks, wearing a mask to cover your nose and mouth at all times in public areas, engaging in appropriate physical distancing and not attending the event if you are ill or have been recently exposed to COVID-19.

Before Leaving Home

- Follow relevant guidance provided by the World Health Organization (WHO), the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), and your local health authority.
- Adhere to government issued travel restrictions and guidance issued by the region you will be traveling to and the region you are traveling from.
- Evaluate your own health and that of people you are in close contact with and email Karen Bilak, AWCI's Director of Convention & Conferences, at bilak@awci.org if you have concerns.

During the Convention and Trade Show

- Follow everyday preventive actions to help prevent the spread of respiratory viruses including:
 - Washing hands often with soap and water for at least twenty (20) seconds or using an alcohol-based sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol.
 - Avoiding touching eyes, nose, and mouth.
 - Covering your nose and mouth when coughing or sneezing. Discard used tissues in the trash.
 - Cleaning and disinfecting frequently touched objects and surfaces using an appropriate cleaning spray or wipe.
- Agree to have your temperature taken before entering the meeting venue.
- Agree to wear a mask at all times over your nose and mouth, except when **actively** eating and drinking.
- Adhere to social distance protocols (six feet of distancing) and respect others' personal space.
- Contact onsite designated health professionals if you feel unwell or are experiencing flu-like symptoms.

After the Convention and Trade Show
